or guardian of the child(ren) listed below do hereby affirm that 1) the child(ren) will reach six years of age prior to January 1 of the _____ school year but has not reached seven years of age, 2) I intend for the child(ren) to participate in a school which has elected or will elect pursuant to section 79-1601 not to meet accreditation or approval requirements, 3) I intend to provide the Commissioner of Education with a statement pursuant to subsection (3) of section 79-1601 on or before the child(ren)'s seventh birthday, and 4) I am filing this affidavit with the school district in which the child(ren) resides. The child(ren) are therefore exempted from attending school pursuant to 79-201 R.R.S., until the child(ren)'s seventh birthday.

Instructions: A separate copy of this affidavit must be signed by each parent or guardian of the child(ren) herein named and filed with the school district in which the child(ren) resides. A parent claiming to be a single parent is representing that he or she alone is responsible for making the decisions concerning the educational placement of the child(ren). A single parent has 1) an order of a court of law having proper jurisdiction providing that the filing parent has sole custody of the child(ren), or 2) a birth certificate that lists only the filing parent as the parent, or 3) a death certificate if one of the parents is deceased.
